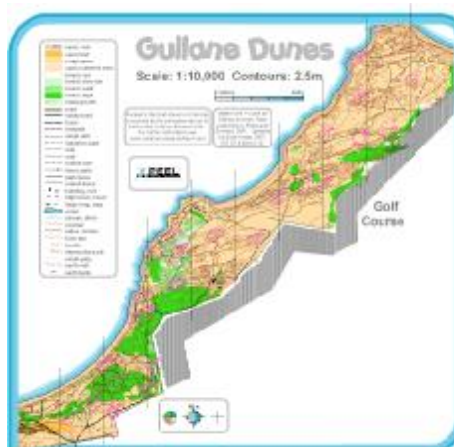

Date: Wednesday 6 October 2010

Location: Gullane Bents, Gullane, East Lothian, NT478830 or Post Code EH31 2BW; signed off the A198 in Gullane village

Map: 1:10,000, pre-marked maps on waterproof paper

Courses: **A Course (Brown) – TD4 – 6 km** – (medium difficulty – not suitable for novice)

B Course (Light Green) – TD3 – 4.3 km (straightforward)

C Course (Orange) – TD2 – 2.7 km (very easy – suitable for novice)

Area: Gullane Bents is the village's award-winning beach and is backed by large sand dunes that in recent years have become overgrown by invasive shrubs like sea-buckthorn. As a result, it makes for difficult, complex and exciting orienteering!

As an SSSI site, the area is protected under Scottish Law. Delicate Lichen grows here and must be avoided. Signs will be at Registration and the Start to warn competitors.

Entry: Entry on the day

Registration: Public car park – Gullane Bents (signed)

Timing: EMIT electronic timing system will be in use; example control at Registration

Facilities: Water and mars bar at finish, no toilets

Dogs: Dogs are welcome in the car park only

Timings: Registration opens: **1030 hours**

Starts from: **1100 to 1430 hours**

Courses close: **1600 hours**

Cost: £2.00 + £1 for EMIT hire
